Pastor Joe's Message

#### "The Theory of Evolution in Conflict with Science"

I've been discussing the story of God's creation from Genesis in the Old Testament during **Wednesday morning devotion**s for the past two weeks, and now I'd like to touch on the topic of evolution.

Some people get very upset and call others ignorant of science if they show even a hint of skepticism or criticism towards evolution. However, science is a tool meant to explain natural laws through observation and experimentation. The principles discovered through this process are called theories.

Whether a theory is true depends on if it can explain all natural phenomena. If it can't, the theory must be revised and improved. For example, theories like Newton's law of gravity and Einstein's principles of relativity have been proven true through this process.

Evolution, however, remains a theory because it does not yet explain all phenomena or contradictions that arise. For instance, microevolution, like wolves turning into different breeds of dogs, is a fact—it's been observed and scientifically verified. But macroevolution, the idea that one species can completely turn into another, remains a theory. We don't observe or experimentally confirm this in nature—dogs don't turn into cats or elephants.

Darwin's theory of evolution suggests that small evolutionary changes applied over time can lead to one species turning into another. It proposes that lower animals gradually evolved into higher animals, like amoebas turning into fish, fish into frogs, frogs into vertebrates, and

monkeys into humans. However, this theory conflicts with known natural laws, like the Second Law of Thermodynamics, which states that things in nature don't evolve into higher states of order; they decay. Evolutionists argue that there are forces driving evolution that overcome this principle.

Yet, these forces do not naturally exist in the physical world without an origin. I believe this origin is God. God created life, and what we observe as microevolution is simply a part of how current life forms adapt and exist, which is the most rational explanation for the origin and formation of life.

### **Prayer Card Writing Instructions**

#### 1. Reflect Before Writing Your Prayer Requests

- Purpose of Prayer Answers: Receiving an answer to your prayer serves a
  dual purpose. Firstly, it brings glory to God. Secondly, it allows the person
  who prayed to experience the living presence of the Lord.
- **Specificity in Prayer:** The more specific your prayer, the more specific the answer you may receive. Vague prayers might result in uncertain answers.
- Tangible Prayer Requests: Have tangible prayer requests. For example, instead of abstract requests like "Please fill me with the Holy Spirit" or "Let my faith grow," opt for specific ones like "I want to pray 20 minutes a day 5 days a week to grow my faith. Please help me," or "Help me find the determination and support to quit smoking this year to deepen my relationship with God."

# 2. Set Goals in Two Main Areas for Your Prayer Requests

- **Spiritual Aspects:** These are prayer requests about your relationship with God. For example, "Grant me the ability and wisdom to read the New Testament in its entirety in the year 2024", "Send a passionate believer of the Christ to our father in Japan."
- **Physical Aspects:** Pray for matters such as physical health, acquiring a new home, children's education, marriage, promotion, business expansion, or financial stability.

### 3. Share Your Answered Prayers

After you receive an answer to your prayers, please inform the pastor who interceded for you. Share your testimony. Testifying about what Jesus has done is a way to glorify God.

See you in June for a fresh morning hike on our beautiful Monterey Peninsula.












# Mark your calendar for our FATHER'S DAY INDOOR PICNIC


