And they said to Moses, 'Why did you bring us out here to die in the wilderness? Weren't there enough graves for us in Egypt? What have you done to us? Why did you make us leave Egypt?'" Exodus 14:11

One of my favorite places to go when on vacation or study leave is Palm Desert. I love the hot and sunny weather. I wonder however I would feel if I had to live in the hot sunny desert for 40 years?

When the Israelites left Egypt, they weren't excited about spending time in the desert. After God sent a series of plagues, Pharaoh finally agreed to release the Israelites. But as they made their way to a new land, they came to what looked like an insurmountable obstacle, The Red Sea. To make matters worse, they looked up to see the Egyptian army coming after them. They went to Moses and complained, "Why did you bring us out here to die in the wilderness? It's better to be a slave in Egypt than a corpse in the wilderness!" Exodus 14:11–12

So Moses began to pray, and the Lord told him to lift his staff over the Red Sea, the waters parted, and the Israelites walked through on dry ground. Then the waters collapsed on the pursuing Egyptian army.
