<sup>29</sup> "The most important one," answered Jesus, "is this: 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.'<sup>[e]</sup> <sup>30</sup> Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.'<sup>[f]</sup> <sup>31</sup> The second is this: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'<sup>[g]</sup> There is no commandment greater than these." Mark 12:28-31
